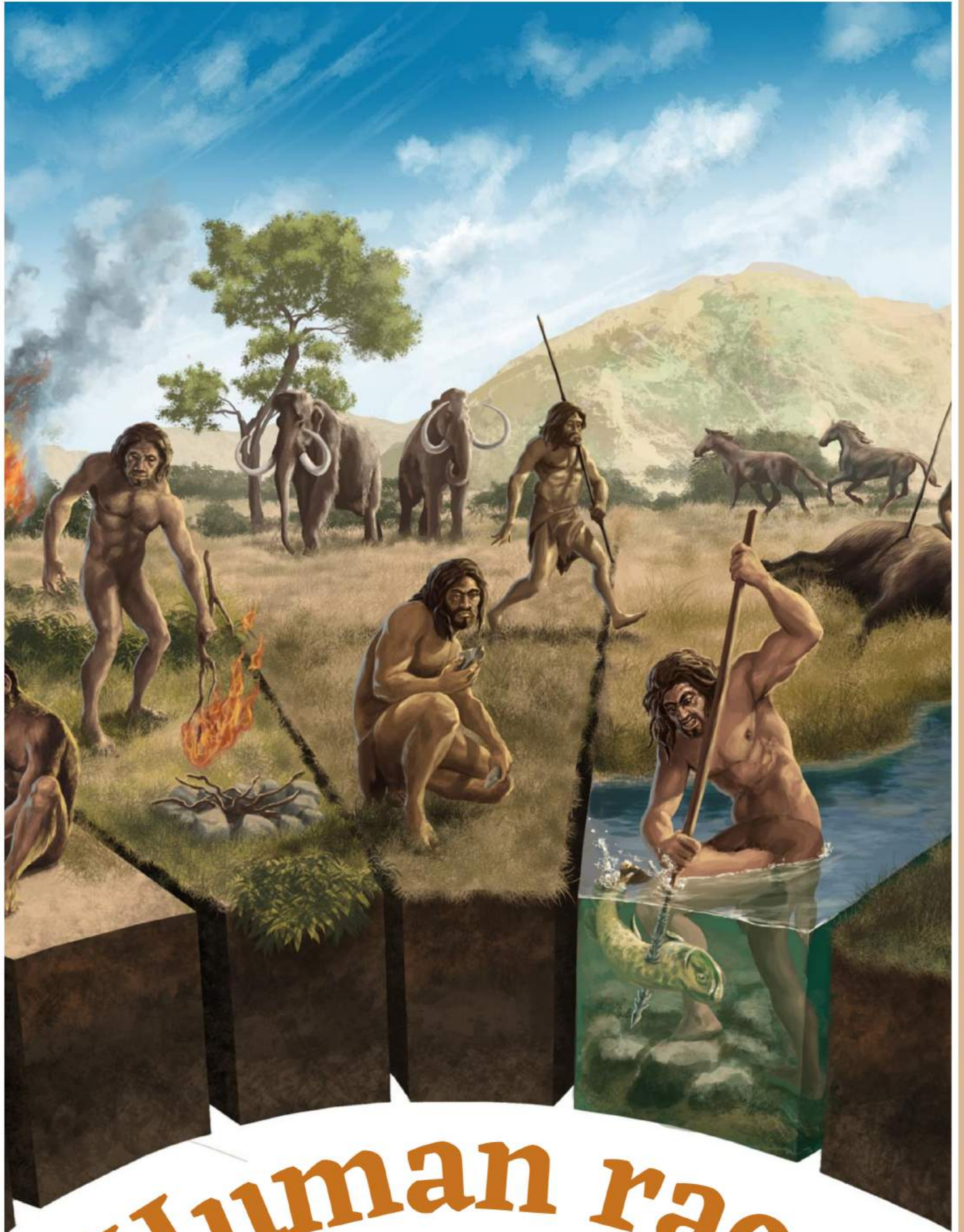



LEARN A NEW LANGUAGE

A Language is a structured system of communication.

The structure of a language can be grammar and its vocabulary. Languages are the primary means of communication for animals and even plants . This is conveyed through either speech, sign or writing.

Languages should enable a recording system for reactivation when desired. Human language is unique among the known systems of animal communication in that it is not dependent on a single mode of transmission (sight , sound ,etc.), is highly variable between cultures and across time, and affords a much wider range of expression than other systems.

LANGUAGE

The number of languages in the world vary between 5000 to 7000. Depending on the philosophical perspectives regarding the definition of language and meaning ,when used as a general concept, language may refer to the cognitive ability to learn and use systems ,or set rules that makes up these systems, or the set of utterances that can be produced from these rules.Language is thought to have gradually diverged from primate communication systems when early hominins acquired the ability to form a theory of mind and shared intentionality. Language is processed in Broca's and Wernicke's areas. Human acquire language through social interaction in early childhood .



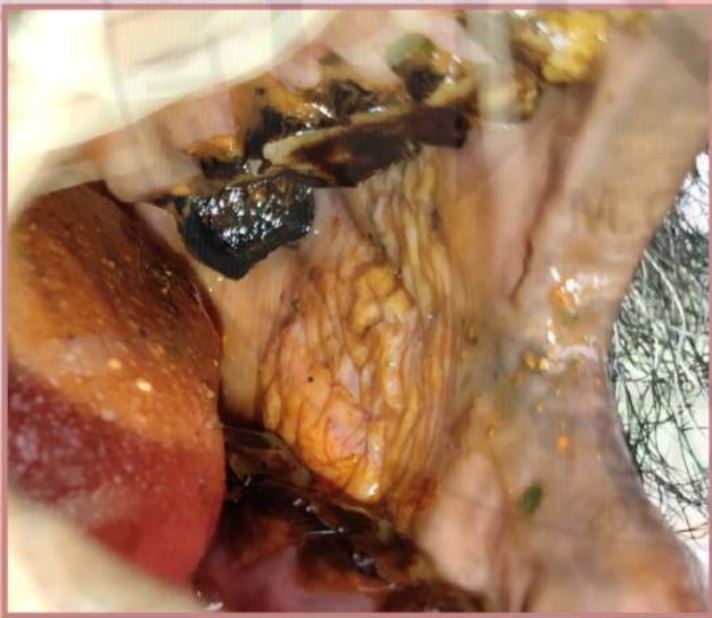

Historical significance



Pondicherry has eight beautiful carved pillars that surround the statue of Mahatma Gandhi. It was Gingee Fort, which is around 68 km from Pondicherry, from where these monolithic granite pillars were brought and were erected in the year 1866. However, the Gandhi Statue was later placed in the year 1965, just opposite to the Old Pier. Gandhi Statue is the third biggest effigy of Mahatma Gandhi with a height of 4 m. Just below the statue, there is a tunnel that leads all the way to Gingee. In the past, the government took some initiative to make this tunnel work by desilting it.
