- Dr. Krithika, Senior lecturer, Pedodontics minuted the meeting.
- Dr. Ramesh, IEC meeting assistant, joined the meeting for the afternoon session
 - ✓ The meeting commenced at 10.15 am and concluded by 4.30pm.
 - ✓ The member secretary welcomed the IEC panel and briefed the members about the projects.
 - ✓ 22 research projects were to be scrutinised as per the program schedule of which 21 projects were Dissertation studies and one PG short term study. One invitro faculty short study of Dr. Harikrishnan was also dicucussed (not presented)
- ✓ Dr. Satyanarayanan , PG coordinator and IRB chairperson addressed the IEC members and briefed about IRB proceedings.
- ✓ A few studies that were rejected by the IRB was directly presented after modifications at the IEC and this was mentioned to the chairperson who looked into the ethical issues alone and asked the chairperson IRB to review methodological corrections if any
- ✓ All IEC members were sent online assessment forms for each project to document their opinion and to be able to reach a consensus regarding ethical clearance for the concerned project.
- ✓ The suggestions of IEC members for individual projects (18 projects) is enclosed below
- ✓ Tea and snacks were provided around 10.30 and the meeting closed with a lunch at 2.30 pm

Comments:

- 1. to make sure that the children avoid commercial probiotic products during the study
- 2. to make sure children consume probiotic for one month
- 3. to make sure children don't swallow the tablets without dissolving in mouth (must chew and eat)
- 4. need not disclose placebo or otherwise in informed consent
- 5. it is not possible to quantify do qualitative PCR??
- 6. Consider need for long term follow up to see how long effect of probiotic is there? If possible
- 7. Consent form needs to be refined.

- 2. Modification in methodology: as harvesting PRF before extraction of tooth
- 3. Assessment of bone formation to be cut down to 2 Post operative Xrays post extraction.(RVGs)
- 4. How will you standardize extractions?
- 5. Try to match the factors like age, site etc and have 2 groups.

Ethical clearance: Deferred/ repeat review with modification.

- 2. Biopsy cannot be carried out for patients until protocol for the treatment is specified
- 3. Opinion of General surgeon and Oncologist required
- 4. Information sheet and consent forms to be modified and detailed
- 5. Permission forms to be resubmitted with the details of who will do ultrasound and the concerned person's signature
- 6. Substantiate with evidence use of FNAC
