Dr.Ranganathan: Segregating frequencies from towers of various mobile service providers will be very difficult and not feasible. Alternatives would be

- Measure the intensity of radiation instead of frequency to avoid involving overlap of signal from different mobile providers companies
- Methodology: How to prove DNA damage is only due to radiation confounders elimination???
- To have a physics expert for inputs of practical aspects as part of the study
- Validate 16sRNA methodology for signature of microbiota as it is not clear what hypothesis the investigator is pursuing
- What is the process in place to intimate the affected population if DNA damage is found to be significantly high Objectives to be clearly defined

Dr.Muthumanickam: The outcome of study may affect the reputation of telecommunication companies and there are bound to be legal implications. Are there any precautions taken in the study for the same??

To obtain appropriate permission from tele communication department before initiation of the study

Ethical clearance status: To proceed after the mentioned points of the committee are addressed
